

CONFIRMATION EXPECTATIONS

1. Community Service hours
 - a. 15 hours per year outside of the Church
 - i. Trick-or-Canning Oct 31
 - ii. Souper Bowl of Caring Collection (Super Bowl Sunday weekend)
 - iii. Food Shelf
 - iv. Homeless Shelters
 - v. Yard work, mowing lawns, shoveling snow, babysitting (unpaid)
 - vi. Walking ditches
 - b. 5 hours inside of the Church
 - i. Help clean
 - ii. Altar serving
 - iii. Lector
 - iv. Song Leader
 - v. Help keep website up-to-date
 - vi. Videotaping and uploading Mass
 - vii. Lead the Rosary
 - viii. VBS/Totus Tuus – Canby June 1-3; Ivanhoe June 14-17; Tyler/Lake Benton (TBD) July 12-16 (daytime would fulfill service hours)
2. Attend Required Retreats/Mission Experiences/Adoration (more details coming)
 - a. In-house Confirmation Retreat with sponsor- likely in January or February 2022
 - b. NCYC- contact Tammy Greenman to sign up
 - c. Totus Tuus In Tyler/Lake Benton (TBD) July 11-15.2021 (evenings would fulfill retreat)
